## Dear Tom:

This will confirm that in light of Superior Court Judge Warren's recommendation during yesterday's writ hearing, San Francisco agrees to delay its enforcement of Proposition H until 90 days after March 20, 2006, the date on which Judge Warren will take the *Fiscal v. CCSF* lawsuit under submission. Therefore, the City's enforcement of Proposition H will commence on Monday, June 19, 2006.

As with the prior temporary stay, this agreement does not prevent the City from moving forward with the activities necessary for the Board of Supervisors to enact penalties for violations of Proposition H. This agreement, therefore, does not affect the City's ability to consider, propose, or adopt such penalties, as required under Section 5 of the measure.
